PROP. 2017/18:291 FINANCIAL BUSINESSES INFORMATION TO CRIMINAL AUTHORITIES

The law proposes that the information provided by financial businesses to criminal authorities should be submitted without delay and in electronic form.

The police authority is also suggested to have the possibility to announce on how the electronic form should look like. The law changes are proposed to come into force from September 1, 2019. Read more

SOU 2018:27 REPORT OF THE 2015 INVESTIGATION OF THE SANCTION LEGISLATION – ECONOMIC SANCTIONS AGAINST TERRORISM
