We have developed our API for list searches even further. You will now be able to choose if you want to receive even more information back; option now exist to see name and quality on the matches. More information will be available in the API-documentation after release date.

Another further development made is the Risk engine functionality, extended to cover information about beneficial owner. For instance country of residence and whether the beneficial owner has been reported to FIU or not by operations.

Beneficial Owner from the Swedish *Bolagsverket* will be put into production in an additional release before midsummer, date will be communicated soon.
