DEVELOPMENT SPRING 2020

KYC – Development is ongoing with a supplementary service within CM1 which enables collection of customer due diligence.

The supplementary service will be integrated with CM1 and the information will be possible to use directly for risk classification of customers.

The release on April 2nd will include improvements related to the API and Beneficial Owners. There are also a few adjustments linked to goAML and some fixes.

NEW REPORT FROM BRÅ (SWEDISH CRIME PREVENTION COUNCIL)

Money laundering reports have risen sharply since the new law was introduced in July 2014. The increase can be linked to fraud and especially advertising fraud. However, the new law does not capture large-scale economic and organized crime to any great extent, which was one of the intentions of the legislation. This shows a new report from the Crime Prevention Council (BRÅ). Read more
